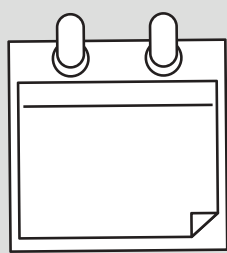

While these days will be quite different from the instruction that typically occurs in our classrooms, our goal is to keep students immersed in learning.

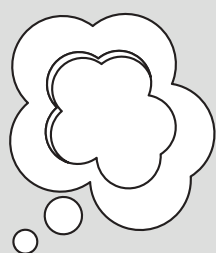

We are here to answer your questions and provide as much support as possible.

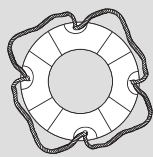

Ongoing Support

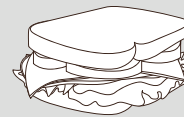
Counselors, psychologists, social workers, and therapists remain available for our students. Please contact your child's school or therapist to make arrangements or call 859.727.2009.
