<p>KCWP 2: Design and Deliver Instruction What evidence is there that your instruction is highly effective, culturally responsive, evidence-based, and provided to all students in the classroom?</p>	<p>Schedules, curriculum maps, pacing guides, curriculum and resources, diversity program, curriculum committee</p>
<p>KCWP 3: Design and Deliver Assessment Literacy What evidence is there that you have a balanced assessment system, including classroom assessment for student learning?</p>	<p>Data folders, benchmark and progress monitoring data, data from screeners, professional development, common assessments</p>
<p>KCWP 4: Review, Analyze and Apply Data What evidence is there that you have an established system for examining and interpreting all the data that is in schools (e.g., formative, summative, benchmark, and interim assessment data) in order to determine priorities for individual student success?</p>	<p>Dibels scores, MAP data, STAR data, PLC agendas, ATM and CTM meetings notes, SBDM Minutes</p>
<p>KCWP 5: Design, Align and Deliver Support What evidence is there that a system is in place to monitor student data regularly and to ensure a continuous improvement model that monitors what is working to support student learning?</p>	<p>ATMs and CTMs are scheduled to monitor and review interventions and student data. Progress monitoring data, PLC meetings, MTSS data and intervention schedule</p>
<p>KCWP 6: Establishing Learning Culture and Environment What evidence is there that your school creates, nurtures, and sustains a fair and caring learning community in which all students have optimal opportunities for academic success?</p>	<p>School wide research based counseling program, PBIS rewards and implementation, PASS Survey, Working Conditions survey</p>
