



MASK WAIVER PROCEDURE

To ensure a safe reopening, staff members and students are required to wear a face covering or mask, which will cover the nose and mouth. Wearing a cloth face covering will help prevent people who have COVID-19 from spreading the virus to others and help to protect people around them. Cloth face coverings are most likely to reduce the spread of COVID-19 when they are widely used by people in public settings. Our number one priority is to protect all members of our school community to the best of our ability.

In accordance with our reopening guidance the Erlanger Elsmere Schools require a medical waiver signed by a licensed physician to allow students and staff not to wear face coverings or masks during the school day.

Those who seek a medical waiver will be required to present the following information on physician office/facility letterhead:

- Student/Staff member name
- Date of Birth
- Medical reason the student cannot wear a mask/face covering at school
- Impact wearing a mask/face covering would have on student/staff health
- Physician Signature, Printed Name, and Date

Student waivers shall be submitted to the school office. Staff waivers shall be submitted to the building principal or immediate supervisor.
